



## **590 Runners Trek Across Historic Pimlico Track During Preakness 5k Steve Jacobs & Sherry Stick Capture Top Prize**

**(Baltimore, Md.) May 8, 2010---** Nearly 600 runners competed today for the first time ever over the same dirt track at Pimlico where the finest three-year old thoroughbreds will gather next Saturday for the 135<sup>th</sup> Preakness Stakes. **Steve Jacobs** of Linthicum, Md. and **Sherry Stick** of Eldersburg, Md. won today's Preakness 5k and earned a pair of Turf Side Terrace tickets for next weekend's second installment of the Triple Crown.

Proceeds from the Preakness 5k benefitted the Maryland Affiliate of Susan G. Komen for the Cure®.

The event featured many horse racing themed touches such as a call to the start line by a bugler, race bibs designed like jockey silks, and a stretch call by track announcer Dave Rodman. Baltimore Mayor Stephanie Rawlings-Blake, Maryland Jockey Club President Tom Chuckas and Komen Maryland Executive Director Robin Prothro greeted the field as they crossed the finish line.

The 5k course started on and circled one mile around the Pimlico course, continued with a tour of the quiet Mt. Washington neighborhoods before it finished at Pimlico in the infield. Each finisher received a logoed lawn blanket as their race premium.
